



All About Dogs of Northeast Ohio, LLC Overnight Boarding Checklist



Here's what you should bring for your dog's comfort:

- Food** – Please bring enough food for your dog's stay. We recommend labeling a container with your dog's name and amount of food per meal, or pre-measured meals into Ziploc bags.
- Food bowls or dishes** – If your dog is a finicky eater, you may bring bowls that your dog is used to eating and drinking out of.
- Dog treats** – We will be happy to give your dog any snacks in addition to meal(s) fed. You may bring whatever snacks your dog is used to having through out the day.
- Medication** – If applicable, bring your dog's current medication and instructions for their use.
- Bedding** - We ask that you bring a rug, towel, dog bed or blanket from home. Please be aware that linens may get soiled and that All About Dogs is not responsible for damaged or lost bedding. If your dog loves to sleep in a crate, you can also bring your crate from home as a comfortable resting place inside the room.
- Toys** – Please limit the number of toys to 2. Acceptable toys include Nylabone type bones, Kongs, plush toys, and certain types of bones. All About Dogs is not responsible for lost or broken items.
